Hi! For full access to courses you'll need to take a minute to create a new account for yourself on this web site. Each of the individual courses may also have a one-time "enrollment key", which you won't need until later. Here are the steps:

1. Fill out the New Account form with your details.
2. An email will be sent to your email address within 10 minutes.
 1. If you don't see the email after 10 minutes check your spam folder or any spam filtering system your school uses
 2. If you don't find the email there submit a ticket HERE.
3. Read your email, and click on the web link it contains.
4. Your account will be confirmed and you will be logged in.
5. Now, select the course you want to participate in.
6. If you are prompted for an "enrollment key" - use the one that your teacher has given you. This will "enroll" you in the course.
7. You can now access the full course. From now on you will only need to enter your personal username and password (in the form on this page) to log in and access any course you have enrolled in.

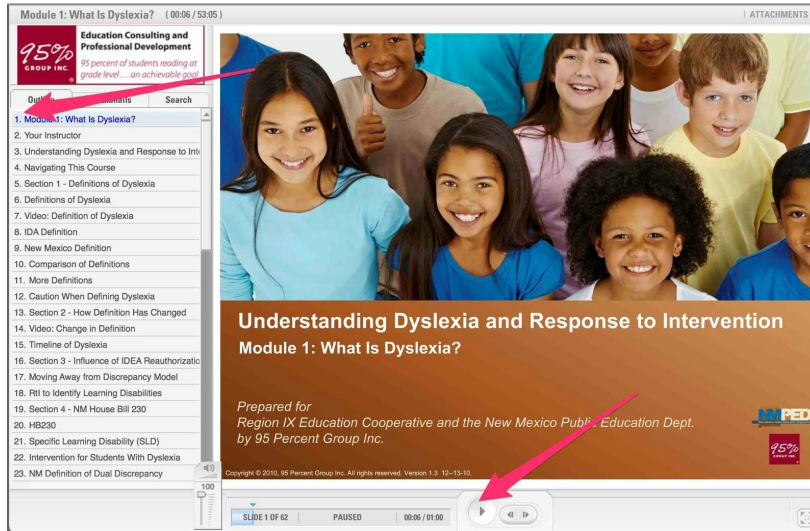

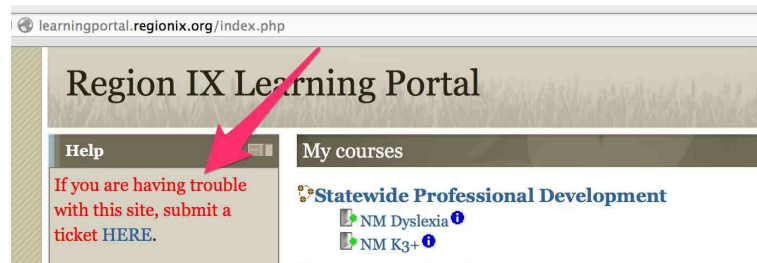

3. Once you enter a module it will begin autoplaying. If not, there will be an outline on the left hand margin with numbered bullets. Click on bullet #1 to begin the training module.
 - a. To advance to the next number, you can click the number in the left hand margin or the right triangle play button at the bottom of the screen. If you are interrupted while taking the course, keep note of which bullet you are on so you can return to the place you left off. The bullets will turn blue once you have completed them.
 - b. There is also a Play / Pause button at the bottom
