- 1. Download Time Tag data to csv and open in Excel
- 2. Insert a column to the right of date and Title the Column "New Date"
- 3. Select all Dates in the "Date" column ie: from e2 To the bottom
- 4. Under the Data tab in Excel Choose Text to Columns
 - a. Select delimited text then choose next
 - b. Check the box "Other" and enter a / in the empty box
 - c. Deselect the check box on tab
 - d. Then choose next
- 5. Choose destination in the spreadsheet
 - a. Choose 3 columns, ie: M2 to O2
 - b. Click on finish
 - i. This has split your date data into 3 columns
- 6. Click in probably F2 the first empty cell in your blank column you inserted in step 2 above
 - a. Start your formula:
 - i. =m2&"/"&n2&"/"o2
 - 1. Hit enter and you should have an American Date format
 - ii. Fill the formula down, double click the blue dot in the bottom right of F2 and it will fill down automatically.
 - b. Then delete the old date column probably column E
- 7. Then proceed to Time Tag instructions
